

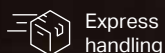

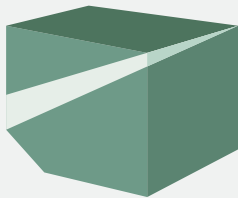

Asia's widest range of cool packaging options if required.

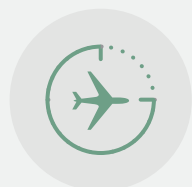


Global connectivity
